

What To Do In An Emergency...

We provide 24-hour coverage. For urgent problems at night-times and holidays our answering service will contact the Nurse Triage Service who manage our “after hours calls”. They will return your call, assess your need, and page the pediatrician on call if necessary. If your call can wait until the office re-opens, please wait, as your pediatrician will be able to provide more complete telephone advice when she has access to your child’s medical record.

Hospital Care

The pediatricians at Just So admit their patients to Brattleboro Memorial Hospital, where 24-hour pediatric coverage is provided. Occasionally, children require hospitalization in a major medical center. If that occurs, we will make arrangements for admission and maintain contact with your child’s specialist.

Programs for Families

We strive to promote health and well-being in many ways. Watch the newspaper for the many community activities in which we take part. Here are some of our ongoing activities.

Reach Out and Read

This is a nationwide program that encourages early literacy. As participants, we are able to give your child a free book at each Well Child visit you have with your child from age six months through six years.

Parent Lending Library

We have dozens of books on a wide variety of topics related to parenting and children’s health. The library is free and open to the public.

From Massachusetts via I-91:

Take I-91 North to Exit 1. Take a right off of exit onto Canal Street in Brattleboro. Go straight through lights. Take a left onto Belmont Avenue at BMH sign entrance. Just So Pediatrics is second house on left, across from hospital entrance.

From North of Brattleboro via I-91:

Take I-91 South to Exit 1. Take a left off of the exit onto Canal Street in Brattleboro. Go straight through the traffic lights. Take a left onto Belmont Avenue at the BMH sign entrance. Just So Pediatrics is the second house on the left (16 Belmont Avenue), across from hospital entrance.

From New Hampshire (Hinsdale or Winchester):

Take 119 into Brattleboro, Vermont. Go over the train tracks and take a left onto Main Street. Follow Main Street up to Canal Street. Take a right onto Belmont Avenue at the BMH sign entrance. Just So Pediatrics is the second house on left (16 Belmont Avenue), across from hospital entrance.

From New Hampshire (Keene or Chesterfield):

Take Route 9 West into Brattleboro, Vermont. Go around the round-about onto I-91 South to Exit 1. Take a left off of the exit onto Canal Street in Brattleboro. Go straight through the traffic lights. Take a left onto Belmont Avenue at the BMH sign entrance. Just So Pediatrics is the second house on left (16 Belmont Avenue), across from hospital entrance.

During office hours, staff is available to answer many of your questions. The nurse may offer home management instructions or suggest an appointment. She may also ask the pediatrician to call you back. Long-term or complicated problems are better discussed during an office appointment.
