PROBLEM STATEMENT/PURPOSE

Patients often have to leave Four Seasons OBGYN & Midwifery and head to the Birth Center for testing or labor. With this project we hope to improve the workflow to better serve our patients. The purpose is to eliminate double registration and to reduce the travel time of patients who are leaving Four Seasons and heading to the Birthing Center. We will know a positive change has occurred when there is a reduction in the distance and time it takes OB patients to travel from the office to the Birthing Center. In order to achieve the desired results, a review and new registration workflow needs to be put in place.


INTERVENTIONS/METHODOLOGY


- Reduce the number of steps to register to the Birthing Center and eliminate the need for double registration during a single visit to the hospital.
- Create a Spaghetti Diagram to assess the current workflow and new workflow.
- Implement the use of WH Quick Reg for the Birth Center to use.
- Staff education at both Four Seasons and the Birthing Center of workflow change and each department's role.
